5. rotating, buckling, cracking, or deflecting masonry cladding; and



report as Deficient:

6. deteriorated materials;




7. deficiencies in foundation components such as; beams, joists, bridging, blocking, piers, posts, pilings, columns, sills or subfloor;



8. deficiencies in retaining walls related to foundation performance;



9. exposed or damaged reinforcement;





11. crawl space drainage that is not performing.
